6. There are 62 endangered species of birds in Ecuador. If Ecuador was able to half that number, how many would be left? Show how you worked out your answer.
7. The following year, China unfortunately doubled the number of its endangered species. What was the total number of animals endangered that year? Show your calculation method.
8. Indonesia managed to successfully reduce its amount of endangered species. They reduced their total to 140. Explain how they did this and show your working out.
