

Science

Go on a nature walk around your garden. What can you see? Are there flowers? Trees? Minibeasts? Birds?

Take photos of the things you see. Can you create a collage of the pictures?

How about researching to find out the names of the things you see.

DT

Create a home for minibeasts/birds:

STEP 1 – Design the home on paper and label it (which materials do you need? Are there any special features?)

STEP 2 – Create the home (i.e. bug hotel/bird box/bird table)

STEP 3 – Appraisal. What was good about it? Would you change anything? Why?

Mathematics

Can you gather data about the weather and record it in a table? You can use apps such as BBC Weather to help you.

Use J2data/JIT to create a graph of:

- The temperature.
- The weather (sun/rain...)
- The wind speed.

Or how about counting bugs in your garden / birds which come to the bird table and create a graph to show how many you saw.

Language

Write a story using one of these ideas:

- A character goes missing in the forest / on the mountain...
- You see strange footprints...

Language

Research to how nature has changed during this time i.e. goats in Llandudno, peacocks in Bangor...

How about writing a newspaper article about these creatures!

Health and wellbeing

- Which form of PE can you do outside? Send us a picture or a video.
- Download the loga Selog app. Can you try the mountain, tree, butterfly or earthworm shapes? How about the cat, moon or waterfall?
