## The Titanic- Timeline Activity

<b>April 15- 12:00 a.m.</b> The captain is told the ship can only stay afloat for a couple of hours. He gives order to call for help over the radio.
<b>April 15- 4:10 a.m.</b> The first lifeboat is picked up by the Carpathia.
<b>April 15- 2:05 a.m.</b> The last lifeboat leaves. There are now over 1500 people left on the ship.
<b>April 14- 11:50 p.m.</b> Water has poured in and risen 14feet in the front part of the ship.
<b>April 18- 9:00p.m.</b> The Carpathia arrives in New York
<b>April 10, 1912- 9:30-11:30 a.m.</b> Passengers arrive in Southampton and begin boarding the ship.
<b>April 15- 8:50 a.m.</b> The Carpathia leaves the area bound for New York. She carries 705 survivors.
<b>April 12 and 13 1912</b> The Titanic sails through calm waters.
<b>April 10, 1912- Noon</b> The Titanic sets sail on her maiden voyage.
<b>April 15- 2:20 a.m.</b> The Titanic's broken off stern settles back into the water, becoming more level for a few moments. Slowly it fills with water and tilts its end high into the air and then sinks into the sea.
<b>April 14- 11:40 p.m.</b> Lookouts see the iceberg. The iceberg strikes the Titanic on the starboard right side of her bow.
<b>April 15- 1:20 a.m.</b> The last distress rocket was fired.
<b>April 15- 12:25 a.m.</b> Lifeboats are now loading with women and children first. The Carpathia, southeast of the Titanic by about 58 miles picks up the distress call and immediately heads full speed to the rescue.
<b>April 15- 12:45 a.m.</b> Orders are given to uncover the lifeboats and to get passengers and crew ready on the deck. There is only room for half of the estimated 2227 on board in the lifeboats.
<b>April 15- 12:45 a.m.</b> The first lifeboat is safely lowered away. It can carry 65 people, but only leaves with 28 people. The first distress rocket is fired. Eight rockets are fired the whole night.
